Agenda Item A: EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP PRESENTATION

Dr. Ghia spoke at length about the Education/Scholarship program and the winner of scholarship award winner Saloni Hemani and talked about her accomplishments and presented a check of \$500. The education Committee Chaired by Dr. Ghia with Anami Patel and Nutan Shah as members, select the candidate based on certain criterias to receives the annual award of \$500. They hope to change some of the requirements, increase the amount to \$1000 and make the award more well-known in subsequent years.
